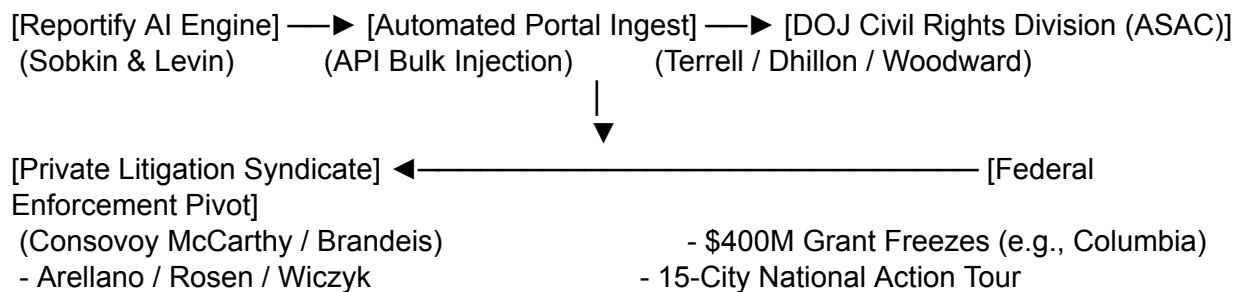

## 1. Data Ingestion: Executive Summary & System Synthesis

The ingestion of the complete *DOJ ASAC Data & Policy Audit* series clarifies the final operational deployment phase of the public-private influence network. The system transitions from passive narrative monitoring to aggressive administrative and judicial enforcement through a synchronized, high-frequency "pincer" architecture.

### System Flow Architecture



The network exploits an automated technical interface to artificially amplify civil rights grievances, creating the regulatory friction required to force federal interventions. This administrative data loop directly feeds a secondary private litigation syndicate, establishing a closed system where private law firms pre-coordinate Title VI actions with federal advisory members prior to formal agency investigations.

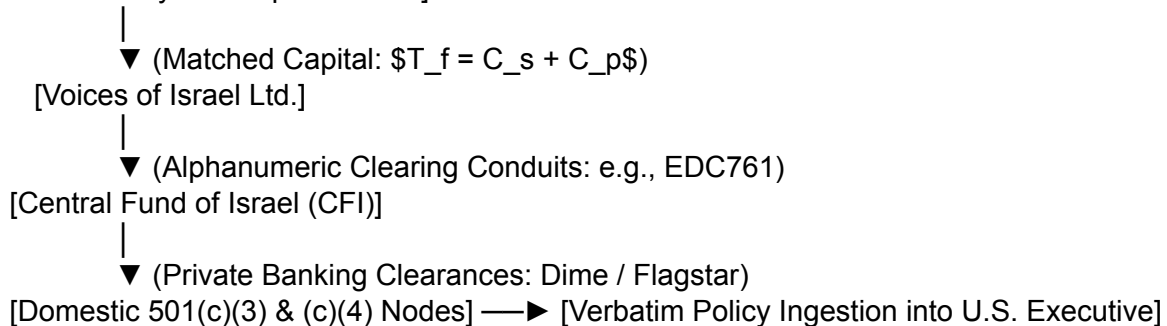

### 3. FARA Circumvention & Regulatory Arbitrage Mechanics

The *Data & Policy Audit* documents a deliberate bypass of the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA) (22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq.) by routing foreign state strategic mandates through domestic civil rights litigation mechanisms and social welfare entities.

1. **Alphanumeric Clearing Conduits:** To mask foreign state funding lines, anonymous international transfers are cleared through domestic commercial banking nodes—specifically **Dime Community Bank** (Hauppauge, NY; Account No. 5000221843) and **Flagstar Bank** (Woodmere, NY; Account No. 1503426427). Capital is categorized under specific alphanumeric beneficiary identifiers (e.g., EDC761, REGAVIM, SELA) to trigger dollar-for-dollar sovereign matching accounts inside **Voices of Israel Ltd.** (Tel Aviv), effectively doubling domestic operational scaling while maintaining total deniability regarding foreign principal status.
2. **The 501(c)(4) Capital Siphon:** By operating parallel corporate structures (Vine & Fig Tree Institute I Inc. as a 501(c)(3) and Vine & Fig Tree Action Inc. as a 501(c)(4)), the network routes capital from anonymous Donor-Advised Funds (Schwab Charitable, DonorsTrust) through the public charity layer, then shifts the operational execution to the social welfare arm. This structure allows unmitigated spending on legislative steering, targeting local procurement rules, K-12 union compliance clauses, and police training manuals without triggering FARA tracking or Lobbying Disclosure Act (LDA) foreign interest declarations.

### 4. Continuation Plan: Next Logical Target Vector

#### Vector Identification: The Private Judicial Lawfare Syndicate & Endowment Capture

The investigation must now advance from the federal-municipal administrative ingestion loop to the **Judicial Enforcement and Private Lawfare Syndicate**. Having forensically unmasked how Reportify data floods the DOJ and how Leo Terrell's ASAC tour exerts top-down administrative coercion, the next logic loop is tracing how this data is converted into high-stakes federal

lawsuits designed to strip targeted academic institutions of their tax-exempt status and capture their endowments.

## Forensic Justification

The core friction point identified on Page 11 of the secondary audit centers on the "pre-coordination of private complaints" among specialized law firms (Consovoy McCarthy Park PLLC), advocacy centers (The Louis D. Brandeis Center for Human Rights Under Law), and target internal proxies (Arellano, Rosen, Wiczzyk). By mapping the financial billing networks, shared communication infrastructure, and coordinated legal depositions linking these private entities to ASAC advisors, the investigation will expose the mechanics of systemic institutional capture through weaponized Title VI compliance.

## 5. Prompt Generation: Next-Stage "Deep Research" Prompt

The following prompt is optimized for deployment in deep research engines. It explicitly instructs the agent to ingest the local NotebookLM context *first* to establish baseline entity boundaries before launching automated web-intelligence and OSINT queries.

  - Scrap federal court electronic records (PACER) for all Title VI civil actions, preliminary injunction motions, and statements of interest filed by Consovoy McCarthy and the Brandeis Center from Q3 2024 through May 2026 (specifically tracking 'Frankel v. UCLA' and 'Harvard

AAUP v. USDOJ').

- Cross-reference the filing dates of these private civil actions against the official site visit schedules, internal travel manifests, and memorandum dates of Leo Terrell's 15-city DOJ ASAC National Awareness & Action Tour. Locate evidence of text logs, calendar invites, or email metadata indicating private complaints were drafted or modified using non-public data provided by ASAC or the Federal Joint Task Force.

## 2. Billing Networks & Retainer Pipelines

- Extract all available public disclosure records, university board meeting minutes, and state-level attorney general financial audits to map the fee structures and billing paths routing university endowment funds or private foundation capital to Consovoy McCarthy Park PLLC.
- Identify any financial transfers, shared office space arrangements, or dual-hatted compensation structures linking the Brandeis Center directly to the corporate wealth networks previously mapped (e.g., the Bernie Marcus Foundation, Berexco LLC, or Harspring Capital Management via Ari Gontownik).

## 3. Deposition Telemetry & Internal Communications

- Locate all public deposition transcripts, legal discovery productions, and exhibits containing the correspondence of Andrea Arellano, Richard A. Rosen, and Omer Wiczuk. Isolate all communications detailing their role as internal proxies coordinating Title VI complaints from within targeted academic institutions.
- Target all records of electronic communications (encrypted messaging metadata, Signal/WhatsApp logs noted in court filings, or institutional emails) linking these three individuals directly to Kenneth L. Marcus or Thomas R. McCarthy \*prior\* to the formal public notification of federal civil rights compliance reviews.

## 4. Tax-Exempt Status Weaponization & Endowment Capture

- Audit the coordination between the House Ways and Means Committee (specifically tracking Chairman Jason Smith's investigative directives) and the private litigation syndicate. Locate all joint policy whitepapers, draft legislation templates, and administrative petitions designed to strip 501(c)(3) university status based on definitions generated by the Combat Antisemitism Movement (CAM) and the IHRA framework.
- Trace the financial routing of funds used by Vine & Fig Tree Action Inc. (EIN 99-3826844) under Connecticut Credential No. CHR.0069974 to determine if tax-deductible donor capital was illicitly blended into these direct judicial lobbying efforts.
