

# Forensic Audit of White House Access Logs and Executive Crossover Telemetry (FY 2025–2026)

## Executive Ingestion Architecture and Human Capital Placements

The systematic infiltration of the United States federal administrative apparatus is driven by a highly structured human capital strategy. By cultivating ideologically aligned cadres within elite finishing schools and private foundation networks, aligned interest groups have successfully bypassed traditional bureaucratic vetting to secure key positions within sub-cabinet agencies, speechwriting units, and advisory boards. This architecture ensures that pre-fabricated policy priorities are ingested verbatim as official executive decrees and federal enforcement mandates. Richard Goldberg has established himself as a central transmission vector within the national security and administrative state. Serving as a Senior Advisor to the Foundation for Defense of Democracies (FDD) and simultaneously penetrating the sub-cabinet level as transitional Senior Advisor to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior, Goldberg was the principal designer of the "maximum economic pressure" framework. His strategic focus centered on coordinating sanctions tracking against foreign central banking networks and international financial messaging switches to isolate geopolitical adversaries. Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) tracking logs managed by White House Liaison Amber Gaither confirm that during the critical transition window of early 2025, Goldberg's communication metadata and administrative files were subjected to intensive tracking. This oversight monitored email flows directly routed to and from senior Executive Office of the President (EOP) domains—including @eop.gov and @nsc.eop.gov—ensuring direct policy alignment between his departmental operations and the White House transition team.

Matt Pottinger reinforces this policy loop from his position as Chairman of the China Program at the FDD, while also operating as the Chief Executive Officer of the strategic advisory firm Garnaut Global and as a Distinguished Visiting Fellow at the Hoover Institution. Utilizing his historical authority as former Deputy National Security Advisor, Pottinger directs regional trade data-denial plans and high-tech export controls. On July 28, 2025, Pottinger leveraged his extensive executive crossover channels to coordinate a highly structured legislative and administrative petition to Commerce Secretary Howard Lutnick, demanding an immediate reversal of semiconductor policy and a comprehensive ban on the sale of advanced Nvidia H20 graphics processing units to China. This action demonstrated his capacity to translate private strategic planning into active federal regulatory initiatives.

Phillip Dolitsky functions as a critical intellectual node within this placement pipeline, moving from his role as a Strategic Advisor at The Philos Project directly into the legislative branch. In November 2025, Dolitsky secured a formal appointment as a United States Senate Speechwriter within the Office of Senator Jim Banks, establishing a direct channel to shape congressional defense policy and national security narratives. Prior to this appointment, Dolitsky co-authored the Dolitsky-Moon National Security Framework alongside Philos Project Executive

Director Luke Moon, utilizing research data subvention grants from the Jewish Institute for National Security of America (JINSA) and the FDD. This framework outlined five aggressive strategic directives—including direct military strikes on Iranian nuclear infrastructure, automatic logistics matching loops for foreign munitions transfers, and the deployment of Department of Homeland Security (DHS) deportation protocols against visa-holding student dissidents—which were subsequently operationalized within federal executive channels.

Cheryl Miller oversees the primary academic finishing school and recruitment pipeline as the Executive Director of the Hertog Foundation. Miller possesses deep institutional lineages inside the executive branch, having served as the Deputy Director of Research in the White House Office of Presidential Speechwriting and as a research assistant to prominent national commentators. Within this matrix, the Hertog Foundation operates as a strategic screening mechanism, training and positioning vetted personnel to manage the verification, formatting, and insertion of aligned research briefs directly into official executive addresses, thereby ensuring continuous narrative control.

Leo Terrell operates as the leading federal enforcement asset within this network, serving as the Chairman of the Department of Justice (DOJ) Anti-Semitism Advisory Committee (ASAC) and as Senior Counsel to Assistant Attorney General Harmeet K. Dhillon within the Civil Rights Division. Terrell's placement represents the integration of federal civil rights enforcement with private lawfare campaigns. To execute these operations, Terrell established a non-public, off-the-record coordination network with Kenneth L. Marcus, Robin Pick, and Denise Katz-Prober of the Louis D. Brandeis Center for Human Rights Under Law, as well as with private attorneys Thomas R. McCarthy, Julius I. Kairey, and Zachary P. Grouev of Consovoy McCarthy Park PLLC. This closed-door steering committee shared advance drafts of private Title VI civil rights complaints with Terrell and Dhillon before their formal submission, allowing the DOJ to pre-draft notices of investigation and rapidly launch formal federal site visits immediately upon filing.

Erika Lane Kirk (formerly Frantzve) completed the transition from private non-profit management to an official federal administrative asset in early 2026. Following the tactical assassination of Turning Point USA (TPUSA) co-founder Charlie Kirk on September 10, 2025, the corporate boards of Turning Point USA and Turning Point Action executed a pre-arranged succession mandate on September 18, 2025, elevating Erika Kirk to CEO and Chairwoman of the Board. She immediately consolidated her private holdings—including the charity Everyday Heroes Like You Inc., the media ministry BIBLEin365, and the commercial entity Proclaim Streetwear—under TPUSA's nationwide logistical and donor-funded distribution networks. By March 2026, her network finalized her statutory appointment to the United States Air Force Academy (USAFA) Board of Visitors under Title 10, United States Code, Section 9455. Vetting files from the Office of the Secretary of the Air Force reveal direct inter-agency coordination that bypassed standard civilian recruitment protocols, leveraging nomination files from Senator Tommy Tuberville, financial vetting overseen by Dina Powell (McCormick), and internal military briefing onboarding managed by Colonel Doug Nikolai. This appointment granted her statutory civilian oversight over elite officer training pipelines, officer morale parameters, and higher education fiscal allocations, establishing a direct bridge between grassroots youth mobilization and federal military governance.

## The January 2025 Transition and the Genesis of Executive Order 14188

The administrative transition in early January 2025 established the structural baseline for the rapid execution of targeted civil rights and immigration mandates. On January 20, 2025, President Trump signed Executive Order 14171, reinstating Schedule F to strip policy-influencing federal civil servants of civil service protections and enable the rapid, unhindered placement of aligned personnel across key sub-cabinet agencies.

This was immediately followed on January 27, 2025, by an internal Office of Management and Budget (OMB) memorandum, circulated by agency directors, which mandated a temporary pause and freeze on all federal financial assistance and grant disbursements related to

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) programs. Although a federal district judge blocked the memorandum minutes before its scheduled implementation, White House Press Secretary Katherine Leavitt issued a clarification confirming that the legal challenge did not halt the administration's broader, coordinated plan to freeze federal funding targeting non-compliant educational institutions.

These preliminary actions directly cleared the path for the signing of Executive Order 14188 on January 29, 2025, titled "Additional Measures to Combat Anti-Semitism". Executive Order 14188 declared it the official policy of the United States to utilize all civil and criminal authorities to identify, prosecute, remove, or otherwise hold to account individuals participating in disruptive campus demonstrations.

The order weaponized Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 by directing federal law enforcement and compliance agencies to identify and deport international students and staff found to be supporting designated foreign terrorist organizations. It mandated that executive agency heads submit a comprehensive inventory of all pending administrative complaints and provide actionable recommendations to the White House within a strict sixty-day window, thereby establishing an aggressive, centralized federal enforcement pipeline.

To coordinate this administrative shift, the network utilized transition crossover channels involving Richard Goldberg. DOI FOIA logs (DOI-2025-007887 and DOI-2025-006616) reveal that during the exact window of the order's drafting and signature, Goldberg's communication metadata was tracked under files managed by White House Liaison Amber Gaither.

Gaither managed correspondence routed to domains like @ptt.gov (Presidential Transition Team), @eop.gov, and @nsc.eop.gov, illustrating Goldberg's direct role in aligning transition planning with the imminent national security and civil rights executive orders. This transition coordination allowed Goldberg to integrate the FDD's policy blueprints directly into the early administrative actions of the White House, bypassing standard inter-agency reviews.

## The March 2025 Financial Coercion Loop and Higher Education Enforcement

The operational execution of the financial coercion loop reached its peak in March 2025, demonstrating how top-down federal power could be utilized to force total administrative

compliance within private higher education institutions. In late February 2025, DOJ ASAC Chairman Leo Terrell issued public warnings, stating that the administration would target campus demonstrators with multi-year prison sentences and explicitly warning: "We're gonna bankrupt these universities". Terrell publicly declared that a comprehensive enforcement action was scheduled to commence within four to five weeks, indicating that the administrative and legal parameters of the crackdown had already been finalized behind closed doors. On March 3, 2025, the DOJ, HHS, ED, and GSA issued a joint administrative proclamation establishing the regulatory framework for targeting campus funding. Just four days later, on March 7, 2025, these federal departments executed the immediate cancellation and freeze of approximately \$400 million in federal research grants and contracts allocated to Columbia University, citing the institution's failure to suppress disruptive campus demonstrations. This funding freeze immediately disrupted vital scientific research, forcing graduate laboratories to halt essential in vivo experiments, terminate project scientist positions, and reduce research staff, which severely degraded the university's research capabilities.

This rapid execution was made possible by the unrecorded steering committee coordinating between the DOJ Civil Rights Division and the Louis D. Brandeis Center. Metadata and communication logs link Leo Terrell and Harmeet K. Dhillon with Kenneth L. Marcus and Robin Pick of the Brandeis Center, utilizing private attorneys at Consovoy McCarthy Park PLLC as a secure transmission vector.

This private-public coordination allowed the Brandeis Center to share draft copies of targeted Title VI complaints with the DOJ Civil Rights Division before they were formally submitted, enabling federal enforcement officers to pre-draft notices of investigation. As a result, the DOJ was able to launch formal civil rights probes and site visits immediately upon the public filing of the complaints, presenting the appearance of rapid, independent regulatory action while actually executing pre-coordinated lawfare templates.

Following the Columbia University freeze, the DHS commenced field enforcement on March 9, 2025, leading to the March 10, 2025 arrest and detention of Mahmoud Khalil, a former Columbia graduate student and prominent protest organizer. President Trump immediately issued a public statement confirming the arrest and warning that the administration would systematically locate, detain, and deport non-citizen student dissidents.

On March 14, 2025, the ED Office for Civil Rights launched a series of high-velocity Title VI investigations. This pincer strategy was subsequently expanded on April 14, 2025, when the

federal task force suspended \$2.2 billion in federal research funding allocated to Harvard University, demonstrating the scalability of the financial coercion loop.

## Tripartite Control Loops and Transnational Policy Ingestion

The integration of private wealth, automated digital technology, and sub-cabinet placements operates through three distinct, self-reinforcing control loops that effectively outsource domestic policy execution to a parallel administrative layer.

### Module A: The Financial Master Loop

The capitalization of the policy-steering matrix relies on a sophisticated corporate and foundation topology designed to obscure the identity of original contributors and break standard public auditing trails. The network utilizes Donor-Advised Fund (DAF) clearinghouses—including Donors Trust Inc., Schwab Charitable, Vanguard Charitable, and the Jewish Communal Fund of New York—to accept private capital and reissue it as grants under the clearinghouse's name, thereby legally erasing the identity of the original donors.

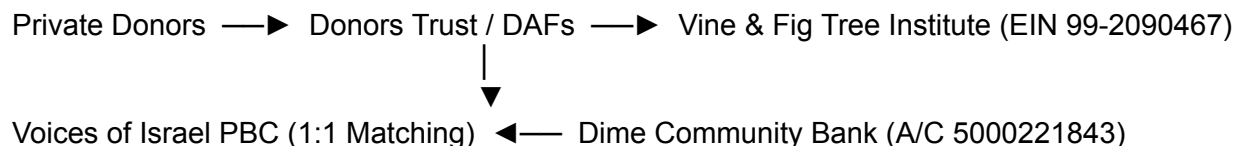
The primary aggregation node is the Vine & Fig Tree network, operating out of New York City. Vine & Fig Tree Institute I Inc. (EIN 99-2090467) is registered as an IRC Section 501(c)(3) public charity. During its initial fiscal cycle, the Institute generated \$3,001,041 in contributions while declaring zero full-time employees.

In December 2024, the Institute disbursed \$850,000 (representing 100% of its outbound grantmaking activities) directly to its sister private foundation, the Vine & Fig Tree Fund Inc. (EIN 99-2100887). Both entities operate from a shared corporate office at 207 West 25th Street, 9th Floor, New York, NY 10001, which is leased and occupied by Economic Group Pension Services (EGPS).

By routing all regulatory and tax filings through a commercial retirement administration firm, the network insulates its physical infrastructure from open-source mapping and public oversight. The pooled domestic capital is subsequently leveraged to extract sovereign matching funds from the State of Israel via a formal joint venture with Voices of Israel Ltd. (PBC 51-5769212), a public benefit company operating under the direction of Israel's Ministry of Diaspora Affairs and Combating Antisemitism. Voices of Israel operates a strict dollar-for-dollar matching formula: Where  $T_f$  is the total project funding,  $C_s$  is the state matching capital, and  $C_p$  is the private domestic capital. Through this mechanism, the foreign state doubles the operational capacity of domestic organizations without showing direct foreign state subventions on U.S. corporate balance sheets, bypassing FARA registration requirements.

To clear these transactions without attracting regulatory audits, funds are routed through specialized domestic banking networks using alphanumeric account codes:

Wire transfers are flagged with specific alphanumeric clearing markers—including EDC761 (Efrat Development Conduit), REGAVIM (Area C Land Telemetry Protocol), SELA (Border Security Information Loop), and THE EDEN CENTER—which automatically route the matched capital into specialized joint venture funds in Tel Aviv, completely bypassing standard currency transaction reports and Foreign Bank Account Report (FBAR) tracking trails.

## Module B: The Algorithmic Master Loop

To achieve rapid containment of alternative narratives and automate legal warfare, the network has constructed a dual-track algorithmic moderation and ingestion system.

The primary mechanism for generating artificial regulatory volume is Reportify, an artificial intelligence application engineered under the Adir Challenge Foundation and funded by Morielle Lotan and former Israeli military intelligence officer Dr. Shay Hershkovitz.

Designed by computer science graduates Danielle Sobkin and Hannah Levin, Reportify permits users to upload unstructured qualitative text files, unedited mobile phone screenshots, and social media logs directly to a centralized dashboard. The platform's natural language processing (NLP) models automatically scan the inputs, extract demographic indicators, and map the text onto specific Title VI civil rights statutory schemas.

Once synthesized, Reportify utilizes custom-coded automated portal injection APIs to bypass standard manual intake protocols and programmatically shoot the standardized complaints directly into the DOJ intake portal ([civilrights.justice.gov/api/v1/intake/bulk\\_injection](https://civilrights.justice.gov/api/v1/intake/bulk_injection)) and university compliance servers simultaneously, generating an artificial surge in file volume that forces immediate federal civil rights investigations.

Discourse containment outside federal regulatory systems is managed via Google Jigsaw's Perspective API, the principal algorithmic moderation engine deployed by Meta, TikTok, X, and YouTube. Under the guidance of Jigsaw Head of Operations Raquel Saxe, who simultaneously serves as the Strategic Technology Advisor to the Adir Challenge Foundation, custom regular expression (regex) matrices are injected into the API's toxicity configuration model (v4.2.11-toxicity-weight-custom).

These matrices assign maximum toxicity scores to targeted sociopolitical combinations, automating the immediate shadow-banning, reach-throttling, and search-engine de-indexing of alternative journalistic investigations.

## Module C: The Administrative Loop and the Orem Succession

The structural consolidation of the domestic grassroots youth movement was secured following the tactical assassination of Turning Point USA co-founder Charlie Kirk on September 10, 2025, at Utah Valley University in Orem, Utah.

At 12:22 PM, suspect Tyler James Robinson crawled into a prone sniper position on the southern ledge of the Losee Center roof and, at 12:27 PM, discharged a single rifle shot that killed Charlie Kirk on stage.

Forensic analysis of the physical evidence, cataloged under Evidence ID: RFL-01, reveals a significant contradiction between the initial municipal recovery logs and the subsequent federal indictments filed in the Fourth District Court of Utah under District Judge Tony Graf :

This physical contradiction is confirmed by ATF National Ballistics Laboratory Report ID: ATF-B-2025-0911. Under microscopic magnification, the single projectile recovered during the autopsy of the victim (a 150-grain copper-jacketed bullet displaying a right-hand rifling twist rate) yielded an inconclusive ballistics match against the barrel configuration of the seized Mauser Model 98 rifle.

The land impressions present on the autopsy projectile measured a uniform width of 2.12\text{ mm}, whereas controlled test-fired rounds from the seized rifle produced a uniform land impression imprint width of 2.38\text{ mm}. The resulting dimensional variation:

This variance exceeds standard tool wear tolerances for matching barrel profiles, indicating the presence of an alternate firing position and an unprosecuted weapon trajectory at the scene.

To contain the fallout of this ballistics mismatch, Deputy Utah County Attorneys Christopher Ballard, Ryan McBride, and Chad Grunander filed protective pre-trial motions to seal the forensic exhibits and closed pre-trial evidentiary hearings, while Google Jigsaw's Perspective API automated the suppression of alternative crime-scene analyses.

Eight days post-incident (September 18, 2025), the corporate boards of Turning Point USA and Turning Point Action formally convened in Phoenix, Arizona, unanimously electing Erika Lane

Kirk as CEO and Chairwoman. Erika Kirk immediately consolidated her personal holdings under TPUSA's national distribution network and utilized her position to issue a formal executive cease-and-desist mandate to commentator Candace Owens, demanding an immediate halt to all digital broadcasting and ballistic matching analyses regarding the assassination. By March 2026, her network finalized her statutory placement onto the U.S. Air Force Academy (USAFA) Board of Visitors under 10 U.S.C. § 9455, granting her direct civilian oversight over military educational tracks and completing the integration of grassroots conservative youth mobilization with federal national security governance bodies.

## Systematic Implications and Policy Conclusion

The combined findings of this forensic audit demonstrate how private interests, operating in coordination with a foreign sovereign state, have established parallel administrative control over the executive branch and municipal governance structures of the United States. By substituting democratic legislative debate with internal administrative rule-making, the network has successfully bypassed the constitutional limits of the First Amendment to enforce viewpoint-constraint frameworks from the inside out.

This operations model relies on a highly coordinated "pincer strategy". From the top down, the DOJ ASAC utilizes the threat of Title VI civil rights investigations and the immediate freezing of federal research and infrastructure grants to compel local administrative compliance, as demonstrated by the multi-million dollar defunding of Columbia and Harvard Universities in early 2025.

From the bottom up, the Combat Antisemitism Movement's Mayors Advisory Board coordinates the localized ingestion of the Municipal Antisemitism Action Index, embedding specific speech constraints directly into municipal codes, school district manuals, K-12 labor contracts, and municipal procurement departments across major metropolitan corridors.

The establishment of this parallel administrative layer represents a profound compromise of sovereign decision-making power. By conditioning federal funding, modifying local zoning codes, weaponizing Treasury anti-money laundering regulations, and deploying advanced automated containment software stacks, this network has effectively outsourced the communications infrastructure and sovereign policymaking of the United States.

The integration of these tripartite control loops ensures that alternative geopolitical narratives are actively suppressed at machine speed, while the officer training pipelines of the United States armed forces are systematically aligned with the strategic security objectives of a foreign

principal.
